- We will also focus on how technology can expand our networks and help us to achieve life goals.





Ohio Tech Ambassadors

In January 2021, the Ohio Tech Ambassador Network, through a grant with the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities, launched a program to shed light on how technology solutions, can enhance the lives and foster independence for people with developmental disabilities.

Five Ohioans using Supportive Technology in their own lives served as role models through virtual peer-to-peer mentoring events held statewide from February-May of 2021.

Currently, the Tech Ambassadors share their personal experiences through interactive web and in-person mentoring sessions to empower and encourage other Ohioans with developmental disabilities to consider Supportive Technology in their own lives.
