BATTELLE DEVELOPMENTAL INVENTORY (BDI)

The Battelle Developmental Inventory (BDI) is an early childhood evaluation and assessment tool that measures five developmental domains. In this course, participants will learn:

- 1. The purpose of the BDI-3 tool.
- 2. How to administer the BDI-3 and interpret the results.
- 3. How to use the BDI-3 tool in everyday practice with infants and toddlers.

TRAINING REGISTRATION

Individuals will register for the BDI trainings through the Ohio Professional Registry (OPR) using the steps below.

- 1. [Log in](#) to your OPR profile (If you do not have an OPR profile, [click here](#) for profile creation instructions).
- 2. From the left side navigation panel, click “Training Search”.
- 3. In the search bar, enter the ST number of the session for which you would like to register. See the table below for the ST numbers of each BDI session.
- 4. Click the course, then click “Add to Cart”. Finally, click “Checkout.” *Please note that there is no cost associated with these trainings.*
- 5. Await an email containing a Zoom link to the training session. This email should arrive (to the email address associated with your OPR profile) approximately 3-7 days prior to the event.

Please note: The registration deadline for each BDI session is one week prior to the date of the training. Ensure that you register for your desired session prior to the registration deadline.
