EI Breakfast Club

County Annual Performance Reports and Determinations Posted on the EI Website

We delayed posting the State Fiscal Year 2025/Federal Fiscal Year 2024 (SFY25/FFY24) County Annual Performance Reports (APR) and Determinations as we worked to ensure the documents met the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG). State Fiscal 2026 45-Day Compliance Analysis

Activities related to the State Fiscal Year 2026 (SFY26) 45-Day baseline compliance analysis continue. Data inquiries were distributed on May 7 and due to DCY by May 22. The EI policy and monitoring consultants will continue verifying records over the coming weeks and requesting clarifying information, as applicable. Results memos are scheduled to be sent in late July.
